About Us

Established in 2003, the Master of Social Sciences (Contemporary China Studies) is one of the earliest China Studies Taught Postgraduate Programmes in Hong Kong. It is characterised by its **multidisciplinary approach** and its focus on the socio-economic development, social transformations and problems, and policy issues of contemporary China. The courses are jointly offered by five departments (Economics, Geography, Government and International Studies, History, and Sociology) and under four concentrations (Economic Development and Reform, History and Culture, Society and Community, and Urban Development and Environmental Management). The Programme aims to equip students with critical thinking and multidisciplinary perspectives. The Programme meets the educational needs of undergraduates for postgraduate studies in contemporary China or related social science fields, as well as the professional and practical needs of employees of governments, non-profit organizations and private companies.
